



MIDNIGHT MASS 2017 JULY 29, 2017

To All:

Now that Midnight Mass is almost here, I am sending out some final instructions for the show:

1. We want to have all vendors set up by 11:00 AM on Saturday so that we can audit all booths before the show starts at noon. Please remember that all booths must be appropriate for families & children.
2. Set up Times: Set up can begin on Friday, July 28th from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM.
3. Saturday Set up will be from 7:00 AM until 11:00 AM. Everyone must be set up and ready to go by 11:00 AM. Parking is located behind the Quonset hut in a controlled parking lot.
4. Tear Down cannot begin until 11:30 PM on Saturday night. If you need to finish on Sunday, we will be at the fairgrounds by 7:00 AM to finish.

Directions:

The Yolo County Fairgrounds is located in Woodland, CA.

I-5 North

Take exit 537 for Main St. S toward CA-113 S/Woodland

Turn left on E Main St.

Turn Left onto Matmor Road

Turn right onto Gum Ave, Yolo County Fair – Do not turn into Main Entrance

Follow Gum to End of property, turn in (R) at baseball diamond

I-5 South

Merge onto the CA-113 S, follow signs for Davis

Take exit 36 for Gibson Road

Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Gibson Rd E, and merge onto E. Gibson Road

Turn right onto Matmor Rd

Turn Left onto Gum Ave Yolo County Fair - Do not turn into Main Entrance

Follow Gum to End of property, turn in (R) at baseball diamond

5. An attendant will check you in at the baseball diamond and give you (4) wristbands and directions. If you need more wristbands you can purchase them from me or Shelly in the Quonset hut for \$5 each. Vendor wristbands are \$5 from us; if you 'forget' to purchase the wristbands, you will be charged full price of \$10 per wristband from the club.
6. If you still owe vendor booth fees – you will receive your wristbands AFTER you check in with the attendant and come to the Quonset hut. You will need to fill out an application and pay your fees before setting up.
